

**Florida Commission on Human Relations
FY 2018-2019 Regulatory Plan**

Pursuant to section 120.74(1), Florida Statutes, the Florida Commission on Human Relations (FCHR) presents its FY 2017-2018 regulatory plan. The FCHR has the power to adopt, promulgate, amend, and rescind rules to effectuate the purposes and policies of the Florida Civil Rights Act of 1992 and the Florida Fair Housing Act and to govern the proceedings of the commission in accordance with chapter 120. There were no laws enacted or amended during the previous twelve months that create or modify the duties of the FCHR. However, the FCHR intends to amend or repeal the following existing rules this fiscal year:
